Sector: Higher Education (HE)

Mode: Face to Face

Themes & Goals: The importance of Internationalisation and Mobility in Teacher Education. Spark a discussion on the importance of internationalisation and mobility among teachers and teacher students by inspirational speaker/-s: An introduction with a general outlook, to our increasingly interconnected world and the upcoming priorities of competitiveness and sustainable competitiveness within KA1, emphasizing the need for a skilled and adaptable workforce. Internationalisation in teacher education involves integrating global perspectives into the curriculum, foster inter-cultural understanding and preparing teachers to educate students from diverse backgrounds. This will enhance the quality of education and equip future generations with the skills needed. This also aligns with the broader goals of creating resilient and forward-thinking educational systems. Challenges and solutions: Address the identified challenges and possible solutions to increase mobility among teacher students and teachers, as identified by the Working group Inter-Agencies Erasmus+ 'European mobility of future teachers, teachers and trainers', 2022-2023.

Recommended for: Administrative staff, teaching staff teacher and other support staff responsible for teacher training programmes. Participants must be Experienced beneficiaries of Erasmus+ Programme.

Sector: Higher Education (HE), School Education (SE), Adult Education (AE), Vocational Education and Training (VET)

Mode: Face to Face

Themes & Goals: Stimulate new ideas for Erasmus+ international cooperation projects, which would promote physical activity in educational institutions. Raise awareness of the added value of sports and physical activity in education and training; Exchange good practices; Provide cross-sectoral networking opportunities on the topic of physical activity in Erasmus+ projects and educational institutions; Participate in “Erasmus+ Run” (September 14, 2025) event by joining Vilnius Marathon (“Erasmus+ Run” distance: 5 km), 2025, and raising awareness of Erasmus+ Programme. The participants of this thematic seminar will: Gain better understanding of the effects and the importance of physical activity as means to increase the everyday life quality of their organisations; Experience working methods on how to increase the level of physical activity in learning processes; Explore good practices; Establish new contacts for the future Erasmus+ projects; Build a community through joint experience with former and current Erasmus+ project participants and other stakeholders by participating in a mass grassroots sports event.

Recommended for: This event is open to all former or current beneficiaries of the Erasmus+ Programme and representatives from all education sectors. We await adult educators, high school, VET and general school teachers of various subjects, who are interested in teaching and learning methods, called “learning while moving”. Themes & Goals: This is an exchange, partnership and capacity-building event which will bring together key stakeholders from the field of higher education to consider how to more effectively promote “Participation in Democratic Life, Common Values And Civic Engagement”, as a horizontal priority for Erasmus+. The event will be centred around four key elements for INSPIRATION (hearing from experienced experts and practitioners), IDEATION (aligning programme-level ambitions with innovative development goals and institutional priorities), COLLABORATION (identifying partners for future exchange, development and cooperation) and PREPARATION (reflecting on Erasmus+ financing opportunities and expectations). During this event, participants will learn from experience whilst also working in groups of national and transnational peers, exchanging experiences, identifying possible innovations and sharing future project and partnership ideas.
