21.10.2025 - 24.10.2025- BERGEN, NORWAY

Sector: Adult Education

Mode: Face to Face

Themes & Goals: The purpose of this seminar is to strengthen the strategic use of the Erasmus+ programme among accredited adult education institutions by highlighting the opportunities available through Cooperation Partnerships (Key Action 2). The seminar aims to encourage institutions to move beyond primarily using mobility funding (KA1) and to also engage in projects that focus on joint development, innovation, and the exchange of practices. Cooperation Partnerships provide institutions with the opportunity to work systematically on quality development, capacity building, and pedagogical renewal, while also addressing common needs across the adult learning sector and society at large.

Recommended for: The seminar is intended for representatives of <u>adult education</u> institutions <u>that hold a valid Erasmus+ accreditation</u>. Participants should have a good understanding of the strategic goals of their institution and an interest in developing or participating in Erasmus+ Cooperation Partnerships (Key Action 2). We welcome participants who: Work with internationalisation, project development, or institutional strategy within adult education. Have experience with Erasmus+ mobility projects (KA1) and wish to explore project-based collaboration. Are looking for reliable international partners to co-develop project ideas. Are able to communicate and participate actively in English

Responding to this diagnosis a goal of the event is to support teachers and headmasters in professionalization of their knowledge and skills within planning of educational international cooperation projects in areas of: needs analyses; formulating of project goals; creating activities, including learning mobilities; planning of project results; Participants will work in teams on the draft of projects concerning their interest. As a consequence we want to increase number of good quality partnerships in school education sector. Participants will broaden their knowledge and skills concerning project planning. Participants will find potential partners for projects and will create drafts of the projects.

Recommended for: Headmasters and teachers working in Special Schools, as well as mainstream schools working with children with special needs interested in realization of projects in the framework of Erasmus+ programme, key action 2. Participants will speak English during the workshops.

Monitoring and Promoting Impact in KA1 Mobility

20.10.2025 - 23.10.2025- RÓDOS, GREECE

Sector: School Education, Vocational Education and Training, Adult Education

Mode: Face to Face

Themes & Goals: This is a capacity-building and exchange event which will bring together experienced beneficiaries working with Erasmus+ mobility actions (accredited organisations and those having managed short-term mobility projects) to consider how to more effectively monitor and promote impact. Key tools, models and terminology will be presented and discussed, prior to inviting participants to actively engage with known impact tools and to reflect on how these might be successfully embedded in their own Erasmus+ mobility programmes and practices. This event relies on active learning where new models and concepts are purposefully introduced, encouraging reflection, comparison, critical thinking and simulated (event-based) and real-world (post-event) application of tools and strategies for monitoring and promoting impact in KA1 mobility. Plenary inputs will be complemented by group-based discussions and exchanges.

Recommended for: Experienced beneficiaries - Existing KA1 beneficiaries with direct experience of the management and delivery of Erasmus+ mobility programmes in the fields of ADULT, SCHOOL and VET: this can include accredited organisations and those having managed multiple short-term mobility projects.

Unlocking Democracy: Inclusive Participation through Erasmus+ 18.11.2025 - 21.11.2025 - CHANIÁ, GREECE

Sector: School Education, Vocational Education and Training, Adult Education, Higher Education

Mode: Face to Face

Themes & Goals: The TCA focuses on exploring how Erasmus+ can be a powerful tool to promote democratic engagement and active citizenship across different educational sectors. It addresses key themes such as civic participation, social inclusion, intercultural dialogue, and European values. The seminar aims to bring together participants from diverse educational and



training backgrounds to collectively reflect on how we can empower individuals and communities to become active agents of change in democratic life. The overall goal is to inspire and support participants in designing impactful Erasmus+ KA1 and KA2 projects that promote inclusion, democratic values, and participatory practices. The event will explore practical tools, innovative approaches and inclusive methodologies that can help remove barriers to participation and strengthen civic engagement. By encouraging collaboration among stakeholders from various sectors, the TCA aims to foster a deeper understanding of how Erasmus+ can contribute to building resilient, democratic, and inclusive societies. Participants will also work on identifying challenges related to exclusion and underrepresentation and will be supported to find creative and practical ways to address these through cross-sectoral cooperation.

Recommended for: This activity is open to participants from all Erasmus+ sectors. It is particularly relevant for those involved in the preparation or implementation of KA1 and KA2 projects. It also welcomes institutional representatives and practitioners with experience or strong interest in themes related to inclusion, civic engagement, and democratic participation. Newcomers and less experienced beneficiaries, as well as experienced beneficiaries in the implementation of Erasmus+ projects are welcome. Ideally, participants should have a role in project planning or implementation within their organisation, and a willingness to collaborate, share practices and develop concrete follow-up activities in the field of democratic participation and inclusion.
