RULES FOR BUDGET ALLOCATION

This document defines detailed rules for budget allocation to Erasmus+ accredited organisations and Quality Label lead organisations, in line with the frameworks established in the Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps Programme Guides.

Minimum grant	Each applicant will receive a minimum amount of: 26.000 euros
	Method: based on average budget requested from previous calls, available budget and on the profile of the newly accredited organizations
Maximum grant	Organizations with established operational capacity and a strong track record of implementation may receive a maximum grant between €160,000 and €180,000. Newly accredited organizations may receive a maximum grant between €90,000 - €100,000.
	Method: average cost based on the profile of established organizations with a strong implementation record, available budget and on the profile of the newly accredited organizations.
