This training consists of three events:

Online Kick-Off Event (7 July 2026, 2 hours): Meet your trainers, the organizing team, and



fellow participants. Gain insights into Youth Exchange quality requirements, assess whether your idea aligns with project criteria, and prepare for the training course.

Face-to-Face Training Course (23-28 August 2026): The training will take place in a remote venue near major cities in Lithuania. A full information pack (including details about the venue, transportation, and group structure) will be provided to selected participants after the selection process.

Online Consultations: Each project application group will plan a 1-hour consultation 1-2 weeks before the EU application deadline (September 2026), if needed.
