### **AI in Education: From Best Practices to Erasmus+ KA2 Partnerships**

**20.05.2026 - 22.05.2026, TALLINN, ESTONIA**

**Sector: SCHOOL EDUCATION**

**Type of Presence: Face-to-Face**

**Themes & Goals:** The 3-day contact seminar focuses on how artificial intelligence is reshaping learning, teaching, and international cooperation, through the lens of digital pedagogy—the thoughtful integration of digital tools (including AI) into teaching and learning to support pedagogical goals, strengthen digital competences, and build critical digital thinking while addressing opportunities and risks. The programme supports participants in moving from ideas to concrete Erasmus+ cooperation by: Exploring EdTech innovation and ethics/safety questions around AI in school education and showcasing best practices from Estonia (e.g., AI Leap), Discussing how AI can be

meaningfully applied in teaching and learning (practical use cases, conditions, limitations), Turning shared priorities into impact-oriented KA2 Cooperation Partnership ideas, with structured partner-finding and design workshops, This contact seminar is designed for school leaders and/or school project managers (i.e., people who translate strategic needs into partnership projects). Be part of the transformation - join us to shape the future of digital pedagogy in schools.

**Recommended for:** The contact seminar is open to school project managers, school leaders, and key staff involved in cooperation projects who are interested in digital pedagogy and AI in school education and in developing Erasmus+ KA2 Cooperation Partnerships

**Additional Information:** This TCA is for you, if you **work in high school education (your student's age: 14+)** and **are involved in shaping learning, teaching, or school development linked to digitalisation**. ## Engaging Young Learners in STEM Through Circus and Creative Arts

**19.05.2026 - 22.05.2026, GAILLIMH, IRELAND**

Sectors: **SCHOOL EDUCATION**

Type of Presence: **Face-to-Face**

**Themes & Goals:** How can educators introduce STEM concepts to young learners in a way that is playful, inclusive, and engaging? This event will explore how circus pedagogy and creative arts-based approaches can support early childhood and primary educators in fostering curiosity, problem-solving, and scientific thinking. The activity is organised in cooperation with Italian and Irish circus and education experts, and is particularly aimed at organisations interested in developing Erasmus+ KA2 Small-Scale Partnerships in the schools sector. It is ideally suited for professionals working in early years education and primary school **teachers working with children aged 4–6** years. The programme will include: Interactive workshops with circus and creative arts practitioners, Exchange of practices on STEM engagement in early education, Needs analysis and discussion on research gaps and programme priorities, Structured networking and partner-finding sessions, Support for shaping project concepts under Erasmus+ KA2 Small-Scale Partnerships

**Recommended for:** This TCA is intended for: Early childhood education and care providers, Primary schools and teachers, School staff and coordinators new to Erasmus+ cooperation projects, Organisations with limited experience in KA2 partnerships, Stakeholders working on creativity, inclusion, and innovative STEM learning

## Harmony for Europe: civic engagement and EU values through Erasmus+ – from common values to concrete actions in a living democracy

08.09.2026 - 11.09.2026 LEUVEN, BELGIUM

**Sectors:** ADULT EDUCATION, SCHOOL EDUCATION, HIGHER EDUCATION, VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET)

**Type of Presence:** Face-to-Face

**Themes & Goals:** Europe is moving through a period of rapid change, where democratic participation, shared values and preparedness are more important than ever. The Flemish National Agency for Erasmus+ in education, training and sport (BE02) is bringing together professionals and Erasmus+ newcomers for an energizing transnational contact seminar focused on European values and democratic involvement. This activity is part of the LTA PEACE+, coordinated by Italy. The seminar will offer a balanced mix of theoretical insights and practical, hands-on learning moments, supported by concrete project examples. Participants will reflect on how civic engagement and core EU values can be translated into meaningful educational practices and learner involvement within a living democracy. In addition, the seminar will provide an accessible overview of the Erasmus+ Programme, with specific guidance on project set-up. Participants will be encouraged to develop ideas for their own project implementation that promote an inclusive, value-driven Europe. These initial concepts will be further elaborated collaboratively through group work, allowing participants to transform shared European values into concrete actions within future Erasmus+ projects. To make the experience even more memorable, the program includes a live performance by the Erasmus Orchestra, a powerful celebration of cultural diversity, unity and the creative spirit of Europe. Their performance will highlight the emotional and cultural dimension of the Erasmus+ community and add an inspiring artistic touch to the seminar.

**Recommended for:** representatives from all education and training sectors: school education, vocational education and training, adult education and higher education – preferably newcomers in Erasmus+ and potential applicants, with strong interest in democratic participation, civic engagement and EU values. It's important having very good knowledge of English (at least B.2).

**Additional Information:**

The programme starts on Tuesday, 8th of September, at 16:30 and ends on Friday 11th of September at 13:00. The Erasmus Orchestra concert is scheduled for Thursday 10th of September in the evening. The format of this seminar invites to active participation, so participants should be prepared to contribute and participate in discussions in English. We expect all participants to participate in the full programme. If they exceptionally need to leave before the programme is finished, this should be approved by the Flemish NA prior to participation.
