**Type of Presence: Face-to-Face**

**Themes & Goals:** The AI for VET event will led to significant results establish cooperation and future partnerships between European vocational educational institutions working or willing to work in Erasmus+ programme. The AI for VET seminar will contribute significant results to enhance understanding of using Artificial Intelligence in everyday professional life and Erasmus+ cooperation. The main topics of the seminar will provide us to understanding Artificial Intelligence, show the innovative applications and tools and allow them to brought in Erasmus+ life; ethical challenges and responsibility; project management and designing Erasmus+ projects with AI in mind.

### **Creating a strong partnership in formal adult education** **06.10.2026 - 08.10.2026, ROSKILDE, DENMARK**

**Sectors:** **ADULT EDUCATION**

**Type of Presence:** **Face-to-Face**

**Themes & Goals:** This seminar focuses on *partner finding and creating strong partnerships* within Erasmus+, for organisations working in formal adult education. The main goal is to help participants finding the right partners and building strong, long-lasting collaborations for both KA1 and KA2 projects. The seminar will give practical insights into what makes a good partnership, how to align expectations, and how to work together effectively. Participants will also learn more about Erasmus+ priorities and how to develop solid project ideas. Through workshops, examples from experienced beneficiaries, and networking activities, they will have the chance to exchange ideas and start new collaborations. A visit to VUC Roskilde, an adult education institution that has been active in Erasmus+ for several years, will provide a concrete example of how Erasmus+ projects can be integrated into everyday practice. Overall, the seminar aims

to give participants useful tools, inspiration, and connections to create strong and successful Erasmus+ partnerships.

**Recommended for:** The seminar is aimed at **staff from formal adult education organisations** who are interested in developing international cooperation and partnerships within Erasmus+. They are motivated to find new partners and strengthen existing partnerships for KA1 and KA2 projects. Most participants have some experience with Erasmus+ or similar international projects but are looking to deepen their understanding of how to build strong and sustainable partnerships.

## Strengthening Inclusion – Pathways to Participation in Adult Learning

**06.10.2026- 09.10.2026, TUUSULA, FINLAND**

Sectors: **ADULT EDUCATION**

Type of Presence: **Face-to-Face**

**Themes & Goals:** This thematic and contact-making seminar focuses on inclusion within **the adult education sector** with an emphasis on encouraging organisations to increase inclusive Erasmus+ opportunities for all participants. Through different perspectives of inclusion, the programme will highlight the different factors that may

affect participation in Erasmus+ opportunities, such as health-related challenges, financial or social circumstances, as well as minority backgrounds or other barriers that can make participation in mobility activities more challenging. At the same time, the seminar will showcase practical approaches, tools and examples from organisations that have successfully supported inclusive participation. The aim is not only to identify challenges but also to share solutions, inspire and encourage participants to develop practices that recognise learners from diverse backgrounds as individuals whose needs can be accommodated through thoughtful and flexible programme design and implementation. Visits to experienced Finnish adult education organisations with strong experience in inclusion offer an opportunity to make observations firsthand and to hear from adult learning professionals about their practical experiences and implementation methods regarding how an inclusive culture is reflected in everyday educational life and in the Erasmus+ projects. This thematic TCA seminar will combine study visits, panel discussions, presentations and lectures with interactive sessions, group work, and speed-networking activities designed to support exchange of practices and partner finding.

**Recommended for:** The seminar is open to adult education organisations delivering or planning formal, non-formal and informal learning programmes for people with fewer opportunities or who wish to increase awareness of how inclusion can be promoted and strengthened in Erasmus+ mobility (KA1) and cooperation (KA2) projects. Both newcomers as well as experienced stakeholders to the Erasmus+ programme are invited to apply. Good command of English language is expected of all participants.

#### **Additional Information:**

Please note that all selected participants are obliged to participate in the seminar programme in full (from the beginning to the very end). The Erasmus+ National Agency of Finland covers the 3 nights of hotel accommodation in a single room and the meals during the seminar programme. The seminar venue in Gustavelund, Tuusula is in the distance of 20 minutes bus journey from the Helsinki-Vantaa Airport / about 1 hour bus commute from the Helsinki city centre. Transportation from Helsinki-Vantaa Airport to Gustavelund will be arranged for selected participants.

### Democracy in Action: Empowering IVET Learners for a Resilient Europe

04.11.2026 - 06.11.2026, ROME, ITALY

Sector: **VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET)**

Type of Presence: **Face-to-Face**

**Expected results:** The seminar will bring together VET professionals, experts, and stakeholders to: gain a clear and **shared understanding** of the key concepts behind the **competences for democratic culture and the preparedness approach**; reflect on effective ways to **integrate competences for democratic culture and preparedness skills within IVET systems**—including school-based, work-based, and dual VET models—considering their specific structures and learning dynamics. Explore how democratic competences and preparedness skills—especially media literacy, critical thinking, crisis awareness, cooperative problem-solving, etc.—can be strengthened through curricula, learning environments, and learner participation. Identify opportunities for more coherent, cross-sectoral collaboration, ensuring that democratic values taught in schools are consistently reinforced in companies and workplace settings. **Recommended for:** **VET professionals** with solid experience in the Erasmus+ Programme (KA1 and KA2), curriculum development, and innovative teaching methodologies, who are strongly motivated to design project proposals focused on democratic participation, shared values, and civic engagement. Ambassadors of EuroApprentices network are welcome, with the number to be agreed jointly with the IT01 National Agency
